Please read these instructions carefully before you complete this notice. If you have difficulty in answering any of the questions you should consult the registrar of births, deaths and marriages who issued the notice to you, or the Registrar General.

1. All persons who intend to marry in Scotland, whether they live in Scotland or elsewhere, must normally complete a marriage notice.\* A separate notice must be completed by each party to the marriage. The notice should be submitted along with the other documents required (see paragraph 2) to the registrar of births, deaths and marriages for the registration district in Scotland where the marriage is to take place.
2. The following documents (which will be returned) should be submitted along with the completed marriage notice:—
  - (i) your birth certificate
  - (ii) if you have been previously married, and your marriage was terminated—
    - (a) by divorce, a copy of the decree of divorce or annulment;†
    - (b) by death, the death certificate of your deceased spouse.If you have been married more than once, only the document relating to the termination of the most recent marriage is required.
  - (iii) if you are domiciled in a country other than Scotland, England, Wales or Northern Ireland and it is one where certificates of no impediment to marriage are in common use, a certificate, issued by the competent authority in your own country (usually the civil authority), to the effect that there is no impediment to your marrying. This certificate (which is non-returnable) is not necessary if you now reside in the United Kingdom and have done so for at least two years.A certified translation in English should be provided with any of the above documents which is in a language other than English.
3. If you are unable to supply any of the documents referred to in paragraph 2 above you must state the reason why this cannot be done.
4. The appropriate fee for the preliminaries to marriage must also be submitted along with this notice.

\*If you reside in England or Wales you may obtain details of an alternative procedure from your local superintendent registrar.

†For a divorce obtained outside Scotland the decree must be absolute or final: a decree nisi is not acceptable.

NB. The documents referred to in paragraph 2 above may be returned to you by post. If you wish them to be sent to an address other than that given as your permanent home address at B7 of the notice, please enter that other address here.
